

## Picturing Writing Weather/Winter Poetry


Combine informational text & poetry to address Standards and teach across the content areas

This Picturing Writing Weather/Winter Poetry Workshop makes writing poetry concrete, engaging, and accessible to a wide range of learners. Learn how to teach poetry through the use of simple crayon resist-based art techniques, quality picture books, and a variety of poetic forms—from very simple to more complex—with the option of also creating informational text. Whether or not you teach weather, this workshop provides a dynamic model for integrating poetry and informational writing across the content areas. With a focus on vocabulary expansion and the importance of word choice, learn how to teach your students to “make magic” by selecting just the right words (including active verbs) to make their paintings “come alive.”


This newly updated unit includes opportunities to write in 3 genres: poetry, informational writing, and opinion writing (on the About the Artist/Writer page). Examples of several other content area applications will be shared.

Picturing Writing is an evidence-based approach to teaching writing designed to meet the needs of a wide range of learners. This highly scaffolded, multimodal approach gives students access to visual as well as verbal tools for thinking. Because pictures offer a universal language, PW provides an enticing, alternative pathway into writing for English Learners and others who struggle with reading and writing.
